

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Reporting Requirements Not Met for City of Philippi WV3300104

Our water system violated drinking water monitoring requirements. Even though these were not emergencies, you, as our customers, have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. We failed to submit the required samples/reports as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

At this time, there is nothing you need to do.

The table below lists the monitoring we did not conduct, other violations, and the associated compliance period.
